The Indiana War Memorial has had leak issues since its construction in 1929. The leak issues were addressed by using SOPREMA's Alsan 500 coatings and Sopralene Flam 180 & 250 membranes. The Memorial is no longer leaking. In fact, this is the first time since the Memorial was constructed that no leaks are present. The Indiana War Memorial is a historical building with large limestone features that could not be changed. Alsan 500 solved the leaks in the built in gutter system and resolved the joint problems with no change to the historic value of the building.
